### Notes

The University of Canberra sets its fees according to an annual rate method. The annual rate is the fee that applies to standard full-time enrolment, which is 24 credit points. The final fee charged is based on the proportion of 24 credit points in which a student enrolls. For example, if a student only enrolls in 3 credit points then the student will be charged  $3/24 = 0.125 \times$  annual rate.

In 2006 the University changed its fee charging method. The annual rate that applies in the year a student commences will apply until the student completes the degree (as long as the student completes in standard part-time enrolment duration).
